2017 Scholarship Information

Who is the KHSTSA?

The Kern High School Teachers for Student Achievement is a nonprofit organization formed by teachers in the Kern High School District. Teachers donate money to the KHSTSA in order to award academic and vocational scholarships to students of need in Kern County.

What scholarships are available?

In 2017, the KHSTSA will award six or more, \$500.00 scholarships. Scholarships will be awarded to students planning to attend a vocational school, a certificate program at a community college or a trade apprentice program after graduating from high school. Scholarships will also be awarded to a student attending an academic degree at a college or university.

Who is eligible?

All graduating seniors in the Kern High School District (class of 2017) who plan to attend either a trade or vocational school, college, or university in the fall of 2017 can apply.

(Children of donating teachers are not eligible for this scholarship program.)

How do I apply?

Applicants must complete the 2017 KHSTA Application Form for the appropriate scholarship (academic or vocational). The form must be filled out completely and have the appropriate signatures.

In addition, the applicant must attach the following documentation:

- ✓ Your official high school transcript.

- ✓ A Letter of Introduction written by you that details your plans for pursuing your education after high school, your high school accomplishments and demonstrates your financial need. This is your chance to tell us about yourself and give us a compelling reason to award you a scholarship. (1-2 page)
- ✓ A Letter of Recommendation from a current teacher. The letter must be signed by the recommending teacher.

What is the deadline for submission?

Completed application materials must be postmarked no later than April 13, 2017.
